Marvin clad-wood windows were the perfect compliment for the expansive curtain wall front facade.

The warm rich feeling of a wood interior was preferred over the institutional feel of aluminum in the patient rooms, offices, and meeting rooms. The one obstacle was trying to find the perfect exterior match for the clear anodized aluminum curtain wall on the project. Several companies' shades of gray were close, but not close enough. Only Marvin was able to take a standard cladwood window and use anodized aluminum rather then painted aluminum..

Marvin was also able to use the same glass make-up as the other openings to achieve a consistent exterior appearance.

The increased thermal performance of the clad-wood windows over storefront will provide a more comfortable environment for the patients.
