

Project Spotlight: Old Mission United Methodist Church Window Replacement Fairway, KS

Contractor: Chicago Lumber Commercial Services

## Project Overview:

As part of Old Mission's 75th Anniversary
Celebration held in September of 2017, the
Board of Trustees solicited window proposals to
replace the sanctuary and steeple windows one
year earlier. The intent was to match the existing
single pane wood windows, with operable, energy
efficient, low maintenance units. Chicago Lumber
Commercial Services proposed Marvin cladwood windows with a factory applied exterior clad
casing to match the original historic windows.



## Special Considerations:

The 6' wide x 17' tall round top windows presented several challenges, from design to installation. Because of the wide exterior casing profile and the need to bend the aluminum, the clad casing was made up of 3 different profiles, and joined together during assembly. The church office building on one side of the sanctuary also limited equipment access, making installation difficult.

The time frame for design, manufacturing, and installation was critical on this project. New dies for the custom profile casing needed to be made, and the windows needed to be installed before the Anniversary Celebration. Marvin was able to meet the lead time needed, and installation finished ahead of schedule.
